NFC visit cards

Contact information from an NFC card is read by bringing the card close to a mobile phone. There is a difference between offline and online NFC cards, based on the information carried by the chip.

Online business cards offer greater flexibility and a variety of data, but they require the phone to be connected to the internet.

They contain **information** that opens directly using a **web browser**.

This page opens when an NFC card is brought close to a phone.

Loading Screen (Intro Graphic) appears as soon as the card is placed near the phone. It's possible to set a logo or any other image here.

NFC visit cards

One of the advantages of NFC cards is that data is embedded in the card. As a result, information can be read and saved simply by tapping the card against a mobile phone.



Display of Contact Information in the Phone's Address Book: This occurs after an NFC card is tapped against a mobile phone. Offline cards contain only basic contact information.

They can be read without the phone being connected to the internet.

They provide information that opens using an address book.
